




- Narrating voice

Reflection steps in a SL project





- 3 tables with paper and markers
- Equal number of participants for each table
- Rotation every 15 minutes (1 participant per table plays the role of the "host" and doesn't rotate)





- Think about possible hints, according to the input in your table
- Debate on them
- Write them down (please, do it in 1st person)

The World Café etiquette

- Speak with your mind and heart
- Contribute your thinking
- Facilitate yourself and others
- Focus on what matters
- Listen to understand
- Play...draw...doodle
- Listen together for patterns, insights and deeper connections
- Link and connect ideas
- Slow down... so you have time to think and reflect
- Have fun!
